Sound and Song CIC Health and Safety Policy

Introduction and scope

Sound and Song CIC is committed to providing a healthy and safe environment for all those involved in the activities it organises.

- This includes but is not limited to; participants, staff (including freelance), volunteers and members of the public.
- This includes but is not limited to; classes, workshops, concerts and fundraising events.

Responsibilities

- Overall responsibility for health and safety sits with the directors of Sound and Song CIC
- Practical responsibility for health and safety at events and activities organised by Sound and Song CIC sits with the appointed session facilitator(s).

Statements of general policy

- 1. Sound and Song CIC will seek to prevent accidents and cases of ill-health by managing the health and safety at events and activities it organises.
 - Actions to be taken:
 - i. relevant risk assessments to be completed for events and activities.
 - ii. Where regular venues are used the risk assessment will be reviewed on an annual basis or sooner if required.
- 2. Sound and Song CIC will provide clear instructions and information to ensure that participants, staff and volunteers are competent to conduct activities in a healthy and safe manner.
 - Actions to be taken:
 - i. tasks performed by participants, staff and volunteers to be risk assessed and appropriate instruction to be provided (e.g. preparing and serving hot drinks, moving furniture).
- 3. Sound and Song CIC will engage and consult with participants, staff and volunteers on health and safety conditions.
 - Actions to be taken:

- i. participants, staff and volunteers to be briefed on health and safety risk assessments for new venues/activities and updated on any changes in risk assessment for regular venues/activities.
- ii. Establish clear lines of communication for participants, staff and volunteers to raise health and safety concerns.
- 4. Sound and Song CIC will implement emergency procedures evacuation in case of fire or other significant incident.
 - Actions to be taken:
 - i. ensure at least one individual is responsible for knowing fire procedures for hired venues and for communicating them to those present.

First Aid

- Sound and Song CIC will ensure they are aware of First Aid procedures, kits and equipment at hired venues.
- Where practical, Sound and Song will recruit facilitators and volunteers with First Aid experience

This policy will be reviewed annually.
